There are six designs to choose from. Each card is \$1.00 which includes envelope.

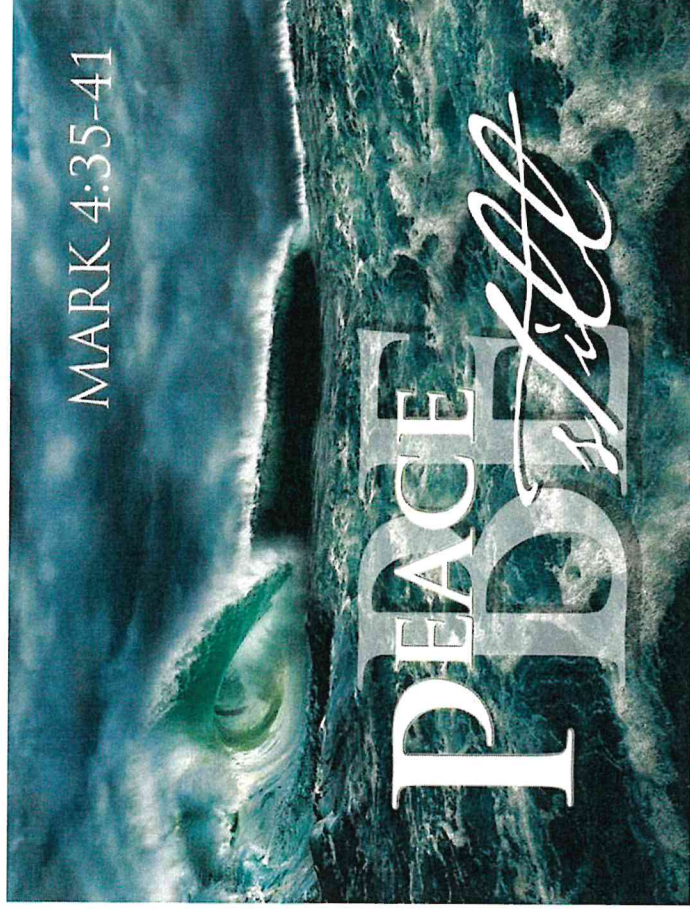
Proceeds will benefit the Church Heating Fund this winter. Denise & Bonnie
