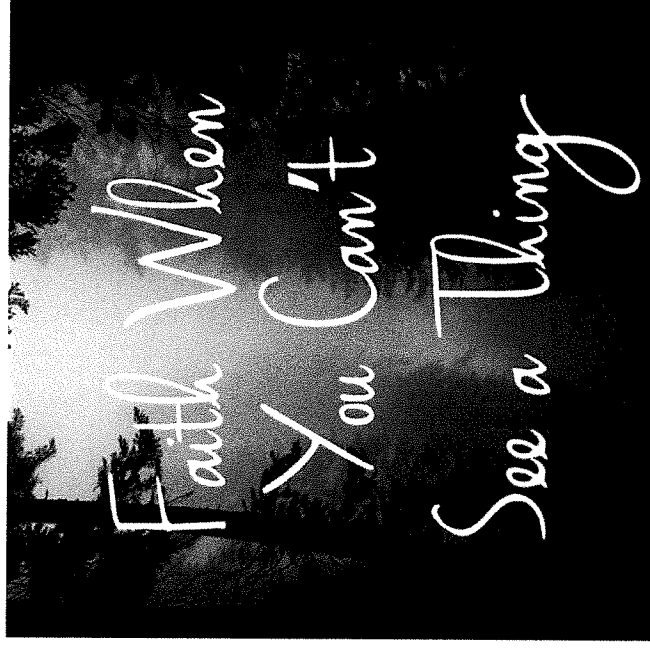
Go out into the world in the joy and peace and love of the Lord Jesus.
